

Explorer shell extensions not working after Windows 10 upgrade

After installing an in-place upgrade to Windows 10 you may notice that the Macrium Reflect Windows Explorer shell extensions are no-longer available.

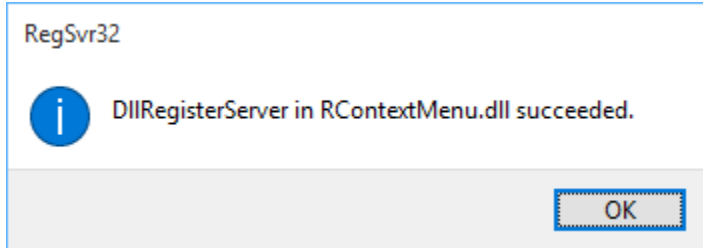
To resolve this issue follow the steps below:

1. Start a Windows [command prompt with elevated privileges](#).
2. Type the following lines pressing enter after each line:

```
cd "c:\Program Files\Macrium\Reflect"  
regsvr32 RShellEx.dll  
regsvr32 RContextMenu.dll
```

Please use your Macrium Reflect installation folder if the path is different to above

An acknowledgement dialog will be shown after each successful registration:



3. Reboot your PC.

The Macrium [Windows Explorer extensions](#) will now be registered and available to use.
