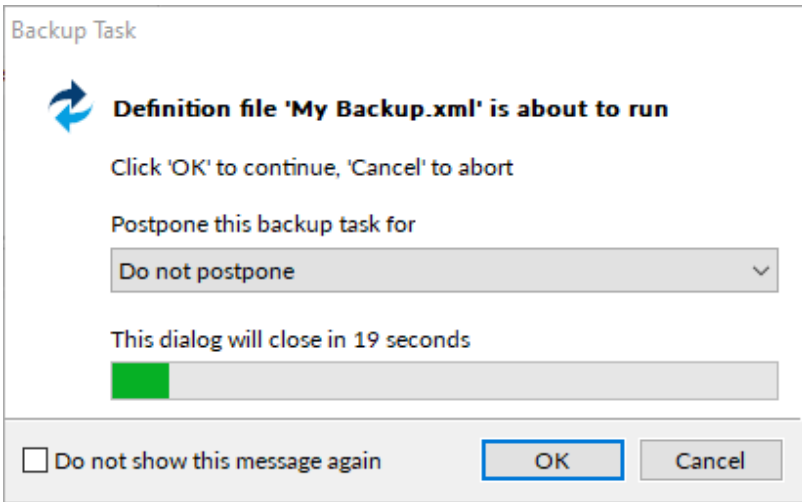
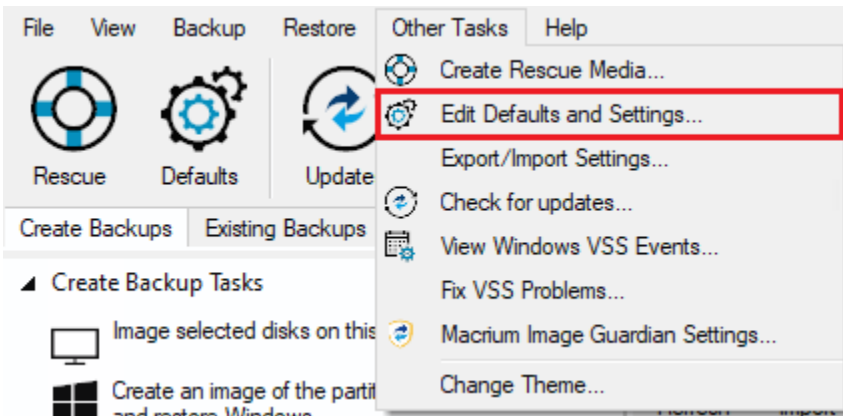


How to disable the backup notification dialog

When running Macrium Reflect as a scheduled task or from the command line a warning notification dialog is displayed.



To prevent this dialog from displaying select the **Other Tasks** menu, then select **Edit Defaults and Settings**.



In the Reflect Defaults and Settings, select Advanced Settings and then select Advanced Backup Settings. You can then disable **Display backup notification delay for X seconds**, or change the amount of time the message is displayed for.

Advanced Backup Settings

- Ignore bad sectors when creating images
 - Log each bad cluster detail. Note: This may slow down the backup considerably.
- Display backup notification delay for seconds (range of 0 to 60)
- Do not abort file and folder backup if root folder is missing
- Enforce entered image or file and folder backup file name
 - Run a 'Full' instead of 'Inc' or 'Diff' if the destination file name doesn't exist
- Show a Warning in the log if retention rules remove all backups in the destination folder.
 - Applies when retention rules run before the current backup, and during the free space threshold purge.
- Only allow Administrators to monitor running backups
