## **Event 513 errors in Windows 8.1**

## **Description**

In Windows 8.1/10, during the backup process, the following error may be found in the Windows Event log.

Note: This error is benign and will cause no problems with your backups

Event 513
Source: Microsoft-Windows-CAPI2
AddLegacyDriverFiles: Unable to back up image of binary Microsoft Link-Layer Discovery Protocol.
System Error: Access is denied.

Note: This error does not affect the integrity of your backups in any way and is generated whenever a shadow copy is created on your PC.

## Solution

To suppress this event log entry you must add the correct permissions for the NT AUTHORITY\SERVICE to MSLLDP service.

Open an Administrative command prompt and enter the follow command:

sc sdset MSLLDP D:(D;:CCDCLCSWRPWPDTLOCRSDRCWDWO;;;BG)(A;:CCDCLCSWRPWPDTLOCRSDRCWDWO;;;SY)(A;;
