Error

If your backups fail with the following message :

Backup aborted! - Write operation failed - Insufficient system resources exist to complete the requested service

then it may be caused by your windows configuration. If so, the following steps may fix your issue:

1. Click 'Start' (then click 'Run' in XP), type 'regedit.exe' and press enter:
 2. Locate and then click the following registry subkey:
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\Control\SessionManager\Memory Management
 3. On the Edit menu, point to New, and then click **DWORD (32 Bit) Value**.
 4. Type **PoolUsageMaximum** as the entry name, and then press **ENTER**.
 5. Right-click **PoolUsageMaximum**, and then click **Modify**.
 6. Click **Decimal**. ? In the Value data box, type **60**, and then click **OK**.
 7. Create another **DWORD (32 Bit)** value named **PagedPoolSize** .
If this entry already exists then modify its value as described below.
 8. Right-click **PagedPoolSize**, and then click **Modify**.
 10. Click **Hexadecimal**. In the Value data box, type a value of **FFFFFFFF**, and then click **OK**.
 11. Finally, **Reboot** and attempt to create another image.
