then it may be caused by your windows configuration. If so, the following steps may fix your issue:

- 1. Click 'Start' (then click 'Run' in XP), type 'regedit.exe' and press enter:
- 2. Locate and then click the following registry subkey: HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControl\SessionManager\Memory Management
- 3. On the Edit menu, point to New, and then click DWORD (32 Bit) Value.
- 4. Type PoolUsageMaximum as the entry name, and then press ENTER.
- 5. Right-click PoolUsageMaximum, and then click Modify.
- 6. Click Decimal. ? In the Value data box, type 60, and then click OK.
- 7. Create another DWORD (32 Bit) value named PagedPoolSize.

If this entry already exists then modify its value as described below.

- 8. Right-click PagedPoolSize, and then click Modify.
- 10. Click Hexadecimal. In the Value data box, type a value of FFFFFFF, and then click OK.
- 11. Finally, Reboot and attempt to create another image.
