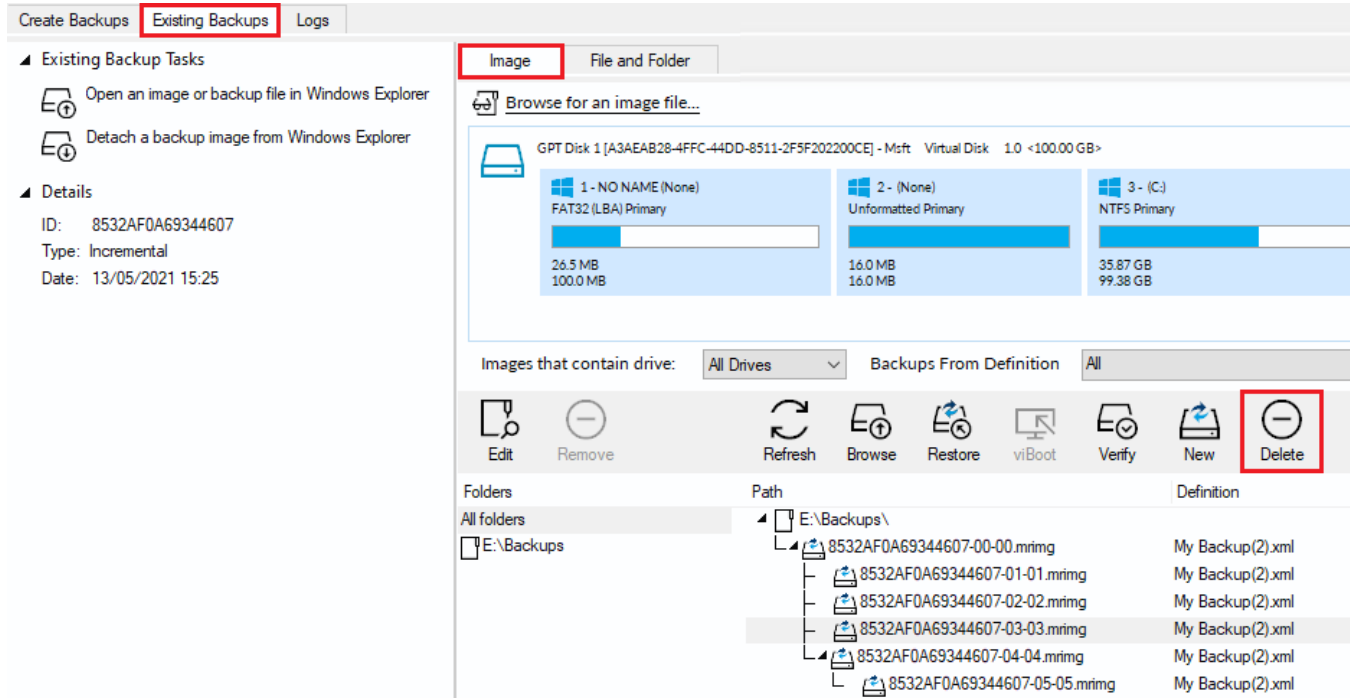


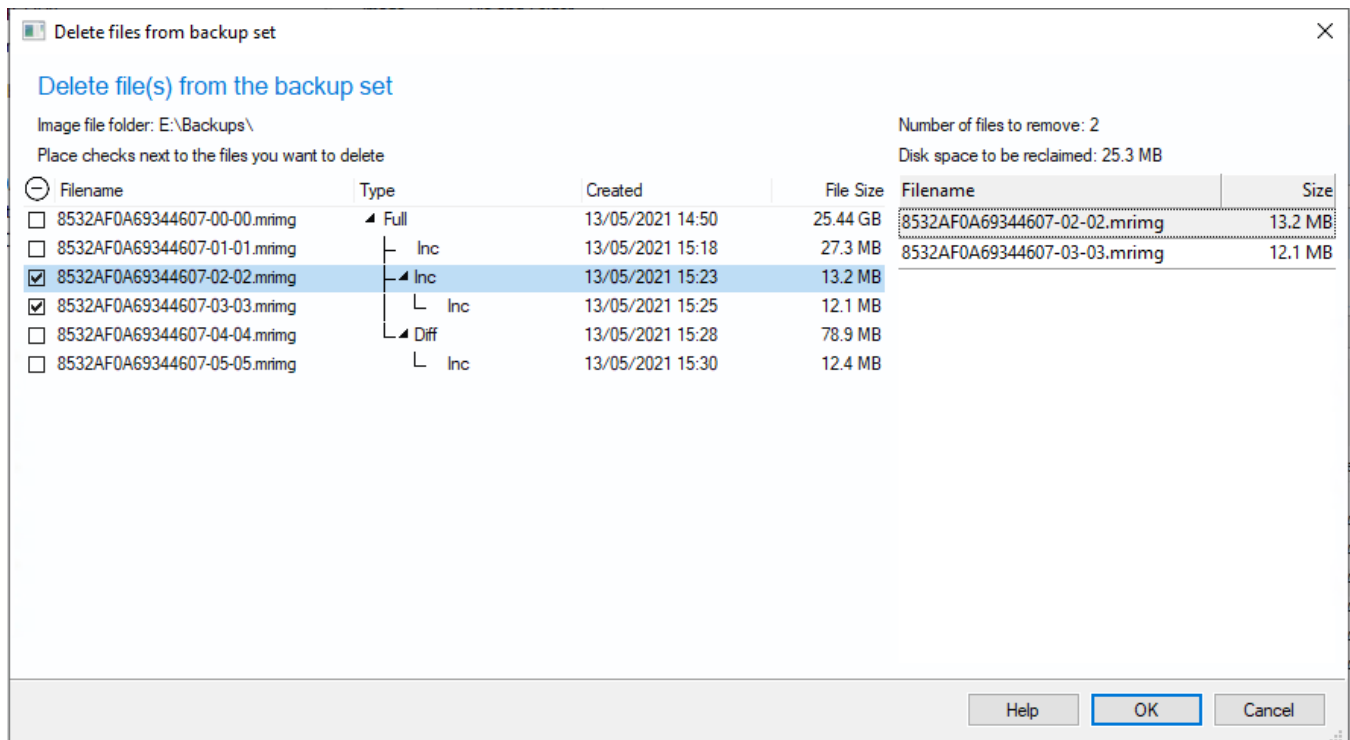
# How to delete backup files

If you create only Full images or Full File and Folder backups then you can safely delete your .mrmg or .mrbak files using Windows Explorer. However, if you create Differential and/or Incremental backup files then we suggest that you use the functionality built into Reflect to avoid breaking backup chains. Select the **Existing Backups** tab, select either **Image** or **File and Folder**, select the file you want to delete, and click the **Delete** icon.



This opens the **Delete file(s) from the backup set** dialog to safely delete backup files:



Along with the select file, any dependant files will automatically be included for deletion. In the above example Incremental image '8532A0A69344607-03-03.mring' was also selected because it is dependant on the previous incremental 8532A0A69344607-02-02.mring.
